### **Saddle up for our scenic sponsored cycle, says St Luke's Hospice**

**When:** Thursday 7 July, 10:00am

St Luke's fundraisers are to saddle up and hit the streets to raise awareness of their upcoming sponsored cycle.

The Tour de Moor event, set for 9 October 2011, offers keen cyclists the opportunity to complete a seven, 15 or 35 mile course, taking in the beauty of Plym Valley Nature Reserve and potentially stretching as far as historic Princetown.

To give people the lowdown on how to get involved St Luke's staff and those from sponsors, estate agents Lang and Co, will be completing their own seven mile cycle. The route will take them from Lang and Co's Mannamead branch at 10:00am, through the city centre, on to Plymstock Broadway and finally the Hospice's main site at Turnchapel.

The cyclists will distribute flyers to shops, restaurants and cafes along the way.

Over 500 people took part in the inaugural Tour de Moor in 2010, raising £40,000 for the local charity.
