

Registering with E Learning for Healthcare and access to E-ELCA modules

The E Learning for Healthcare is an online e-learning package run by Health Education England in partnership with the NHS. It has many programmes, of which e-learning for end of life care for all (E-ELCA) is one of them.

E-ELCA has over 150 modules that you can work through. Not all of them will be relevant to you as a medical student. There currently is a national project which seeks to map the more relevant modules to the Association of Palliative Medicine (APM) medical undergraduate syllabus. In the meantime, please use the mapped APM syllabus that you will find on the St Luke's website to access some of the currently suggested modules as well as the other online resources listed. You can work on these modules during your SDL sessions.

Instructions for registration:

1. Navigate to E-learning for Healthcare website - <http://www.e-lfh.org.uk/home/>
2. Click the Register button in top right hand corner
3. Select "**I am a hospice worker**"
4. Type and select "**St Luke's Hospice – Plymouth (Independent Hospice)**" under Tell us which hospice you work in
5. The Hospice Registration Code is: **L56916**
6. Enter your Registration Details to register
7. Select My Account >Enrolment
8. Select End of Life Care programme (E-ELCA) and save changes
9. You should now have access to the E-ELCA modules
