Who should attend?

Registered Nurses working in Care Homes

Training to include:

- Legal and ethical issues
- Accountability and professional responsibility
- Physiological signs of death
- Examination necessary to confirm death has occurred
- Documentation
- Role of the Coroner and when referral is necessary
- Role of the Funeral Director
- Religious and cultural considerations
- Organ donation
- Information to be given to relatives/carers following a bereavement
